1. **Tax preparer:** training December 7-9 at NeighborWorks Waco, 922 Franklin, and  
January 4-7 at Rogers Computer and Engineering Building, Baylor, and pass IRS certification examination.
2. **Site Assistant:** training January 11 at NeighborWorks Waco.

Both positions require willingness to work two 4-hour shifts weekly, January 18-April 15 at one of 7 sites.
