In submitting your proposal, please keep in mind the guidelines below that will be used to select a project. There is no official application. Therefore, a letter with sufficient detail as to your project idea and contact information will suffice. You may also email me a brief description of your project idea, and I will let you know if you are on the right track and to go ahead submit a detailed proposal.

Guidelines:

1. The project must further the Junior League of Waco Inc.'s mission of **promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of women, and improving communities through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. We would like for a project that specifically helps children.**
2. **We would prefer a project that is task oriented.**
3. **We would prefer a project that has an educational component, but it is not a requirement.**
4. **We do not have a large budget for this project (\$3,000 or less). Therefore, an emphasis will be given to those projects that are volunteer action oriented.**
5. **We also would prefer a project that can be started and completed within a week in February 2011. We anticipate a volunteer group of 50 -100 who would come in one day to volunteer or possibly spread out over the week. Therefore, in your proposal please let us know if your project could accommodate a group this size.**
