The Vice President for Residential Care and Education is responsible for the overall operation of all residential and education programs within the Methodist Children's Home system, this includes residential group care, charter school, day student programs, transition services, independent living, advanced education, and aftercare services. The Vice President for Residential Care and Education is responsible for ensuring that all programs and services operate within state and federal laws, regulations, licensing and accreditation standards, and within organizational approved policies and procedures.

This is a professional position that may require more hours than the normal 40-hour workweek.

A Master's Degree in Social Work or related field is required. Five years of leadership experience in a residential care facility, child-placing agency or related setting is required. Five years of experience in a supervisory and/or organizational leadership capacity is required.
