

Main Message:

The City of Waco and McLennan County together launched the Small Business Recovery Fund to support local, small businesses impacted by COVID-19. The two entities contributed \$830,000 to the fund that will provide grants of up to \$5,000 to small businesses with less than 10 employees.

To qualify for a grant, a business must be located and operating within McLennan County and have experienced a loss due to COVID-19. Grants may cover various expenses including rent, mortgage obligations, payroll expenses and utilities.
