

Counselor II United Way Position - STARRY - Work with families in the community meeting FAYS or Universal Prevention eligibility: (1) 0-17 years of age; (2) Runaway youth (either currently or threatening); (3) Truant youth; (4) Abused children (experiencing abuse, insufficient for CPS case); (5) At-risk youth for other behavioral problems; (6) Youth involved in deferred prosecution with juvenile probation; (7) Youth placed in residential care for family conflict to reunify family. Additional United Way responsibilities: • Fulfill United Way grant expectations, including outreach, services, data collection, and reporting • Meet with United Way for meetings and partnerships • Serve populations that have been historically underserved in McLennan County, including Hispanic and African American residents, as well as people who are living below the poverty line • Conduct services in areas that provide the most accessibility for community members in order to remove barriers to accessing mental health services • Report on services and collaborations to the Program Leaders, Team Supervisor, and United Way funders • Work to increase equity and inclusion in the Waco office by creating and maintaining community relationships and referral sources • Assist the program in increasing access for diverse populations by educating, empowering, and equipping staff to meet the needs of the community
